

Sands Bereavement Care Training for Health Visitors Aim and Learning Outcomes

Aim of the Course

To enable health visitors to develop the knowledge, insight and skills to provide effective care and support to families who experience the death of a baby, before, during or shortly after birth.

Learning Outcomes

At the end of this session participants will be able to:

- Identify the unique impact of grief in relation to pregnancy loss and the death of a baby on bereaved families.
- Recognise the positive impact the health visitor can have on bereaved families' long-term health and wellbeing.
- Develop the skills and confidence to communicate sensitively and effectively with bereaved families.
- Enable bereaved families to access information and ongoing support from other sources and agencies.
- Understand how the mental health of the family can be significantly affected by the death of a baby and the potential impact this can have on all subsequent pregnancies and births.
- Recognise the importance of accessing support for themselves after caring for bereaved families.
