Travel information



By rail: Euston, Kina's Cross, St Pancras and St Pancras International stations are all within walking distance.



By London Underground (tube): The Piccadilly, Northern, Victoria, Metropolitan, Circle, and

Hammersmith & City lines are close by. The nearest station is Russell Square, served by the Piccadilly line (dark blue).



By air: London has many airports; Heathrow, Gatwick and London City, as well as those slightly further afield

namely Luton and Stansted, served by some of the lower cost airlines.

Upon arrival at any airport, good transport networks will link you up with the London Underground via over ground train connections, such as the Heathrow Express, or the Gatwick Express. For full travel details please visit the website of your arrival airport which will detail the transport options available. Once you are on the Underground network, please head for one of the many stations near to the Brunei Gallery; remember Russell Square, is just 5 minutes walk away.
