By rail: Euston, King's Cross, St Pancras and St Pancras International stations are all within walking distance.

By London Underground (tube): The Piccadilly, Northern, Victoria, Metropolitan, Circle, and Hammersmith &

City lines are close by. The nearest station is Russell Square, served by the Piccadilly line (dark blue).

By air: London has many airports; Heathrow, Gatwick and London City, as well as those slightly further afield namely Luton and Stansted, served by some of the lower cost airlines.

Upon arrival at any airport, good transport networks will link you up with the London Underground via over ground train connections, such as the Heathrow Express, or the Gatwick Express.
