



## COVID Safety Measures for the Starlight Walk Edinburgh

### Before arriving at the venue

We would ask all guests to take a COVID lateral flow test within 24 hours of arriving at the venue. If your lateral flow test is positive, we would ask you to stay at home, to avoid this risk of spreading virus to other people. You can order a free lateral flow on the [UK Government website](https://www.gov.uk/government/organisations/uk-government).

If a guest is feeling unwell or showing symptoms of COVID-19 we ask not to arrive at the venue, to avoid spreading of virus to guests, volunteers, and member of staff.

Anyone who registered to attend the Starlight Walk Edinburgh but can no longer attend, they can organise their own Starlight Walk with their lantern pack.

Anyone registered after 4<sup>th</sup> November, please email with your order number and we can send your pack to your home address.

### Registrations and Arrivals

At the reception desk when you arrive, you will be asked to scan a QR code to confirm your details for Dynamic Earth.

### During the event

We recommend guests wash their hands during their time at the venue. We would also ask guests to wear masks in indoor spaces and to socially distance.
